Below is a simplified list displaying creating your own personal private notepad (Conversation). Here are the steps for the image below.

- 1) Begin a conversation by selection the envelope dropdown icon right-hand left top. Choose 'Start a new conversation'.
- 2) Choose a Recipient by entering only your member username, even if left blank, it will use your member username.
- 3) Enter your title (label) and continue to the Discussion field to add your notes.
- 4) Now if you want to save a link in this conversation, open the post that you want. Hover your mouse over the number of the post, located on the top right-hand of the post. This same concept works by hovering over a website URL link.
- 5) Use the right mouse button, click and select 'Copy Link' or 'Copy' for a web page or <Ctrl C>. Paste this link to your conversation with the right mouse button, click and select 'Paste' or <Ctrl V>.
- 6) You can see a preview of the finale conversation by selecting the 'Preview' icon on the right-hand left top. Select it again to exit the preview mode.
- 7) Finally, after you are satisfied with your info added, select the 'Start conversation' icon.
- 8) Your conversation is added to your list. Conversations will always be Editable.








Editing the Post will not place the post at the Top of your of your Conversations. Adding a reply may be a better way to add to your notes to keep them separate. This also places this conversation to the top of all conversations. Of course, you can edit your original post to keep on adding or deleting info.

**Note: This Notepad trick works with the current version of our site software. There is no guarantee that it will continue to work if our Site software is updated in the future. Although conversations will never be removed.**

You could use Bookmarks to track threads and posts per the steps below. But this does not allow adding additional notes.

- 9) Left click your mouse button on the 'Bookmark' icon,  located on the top right-hand of the post.
- 10) Enter your optional 'Message' (Title), and 'Labels'. Select 'Save' to finalize.
- 11) Select the 'Your Account' then 'Bookmark' to view all of your Bookmarks.
- 12) Left click your mouse button on the 'Gear' icon, located on the top right-hand of the post. You have 3 options to choose from. 'Copy Link', 'Edit' or 'Delete'.
- 13) This displays the 'Edit' option.
- 14) This displays the 'Delete' option.
