

How do I Quickly Zoom Full Page and Font Size in common browsers (Chrome, Firefox, Edge, Opera, Internet Explorer)

The solution works for Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Microsoft Edge, Opera, and Internet Explorer. Read on to find out how to enlarge full web page including text and graphics in your favorite web browser.

For all the web browsers listed, you can **temporarily** change the size of the Entire Web Page by using the zoom short cut function. There is a simple method for all browsers by using the keyboard or mouse options.

Using a PC:

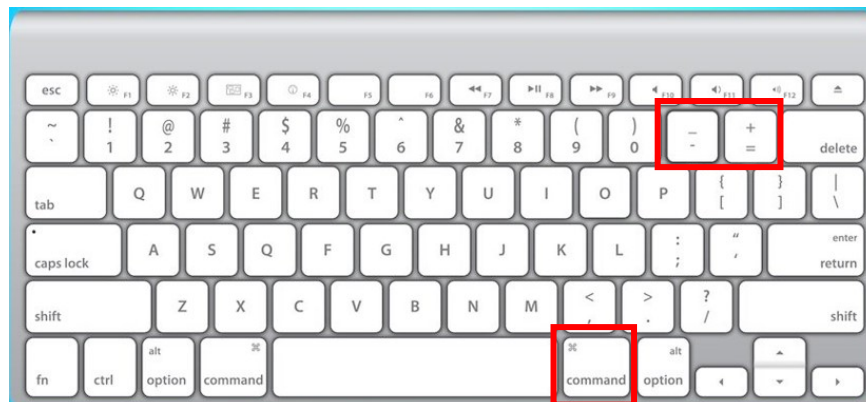
- Hold (*Ctrl*) key and press the plus key (+) to Zoom In to make things BIGGER.
- Hold (*Ctrl*) key and press the plus key (-) to Zoom In to make things smaller.
- Hold (*Ctrl*) and key press the Zero key (0) to return to original page size.
- Hold (*Ctrl*) key while you use the scroll wheel on your mouse to make things larger or smaller.
- Using a touchpad on an PC notebook, use a pinch to zoom in or out as you would on an Android phone.

Using a Mac:

- Hold (*Command*) (⌘) key and press the plus key (+) to Zoom In make things BIGGER.
- Hold (*Command*) (⌘) key and press the plus key (-) to Zoom In make things smaller.
- Hold (*Command*) (⌘) key and press the Zero key (0) to return to original page size.
- Hold (*Command*) (⌘) key while you use the scroll wheel on your mouse to make things larger or smaller.
- Using an Apple Magic Mouse, you can use it to zoom in or out also. Just hold down the (*Command*) (⌘) key, then slide your finger to the top or bottom of the mouse. You'll zoom in and out.
- Using a trackpad on an Apple notebook, use a pinch to zoom in or out as you would on an iPhone or iPad.



These tips temporarily allow resizing your browser zoom level. If you want to change variables permanently, you will need to go into the settings for the browser or your system. This is not covered here due to the complexities.
