


Using the IAP bbcode Editor Presets.

You can start a new thread by selecting the "Forums tab" from the Home Main Menu bar.

Select  in the upper right corner of our page.

Select one of the Forums from the scrollable pop up list. Review these before placing your new Post.




Can't find it if it's in the wrong Forum! After you choose the Forum you'll be placed in that forum, ready for you.

Enter A Thread title and click in the shaded area below the editing icons, to begin your post.



You do not need to use any of the icons above when creating/starting a Post/Thread.






If you are Posting a Reply, you may instead see the following editor.

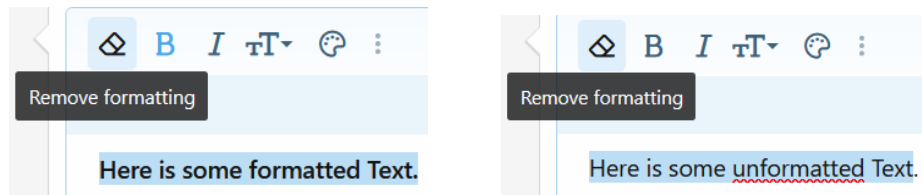
  

In this editor, the icons are not located as the examples in this document show.

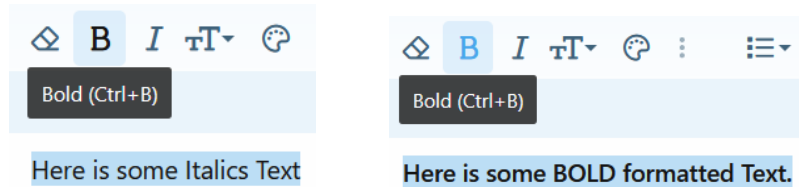
We'll use the Editing Icons in this tutorial to learn the usage. In another document I will describe using manual bbcode.

Let's go through each of the Editing Icons with simple instructions. **Most actions require your text to be selected.**

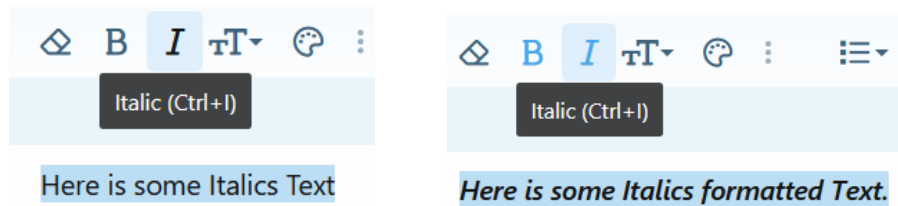
For anything that you may have added formatting to, you can remove it using the **Remove formatting** icon.



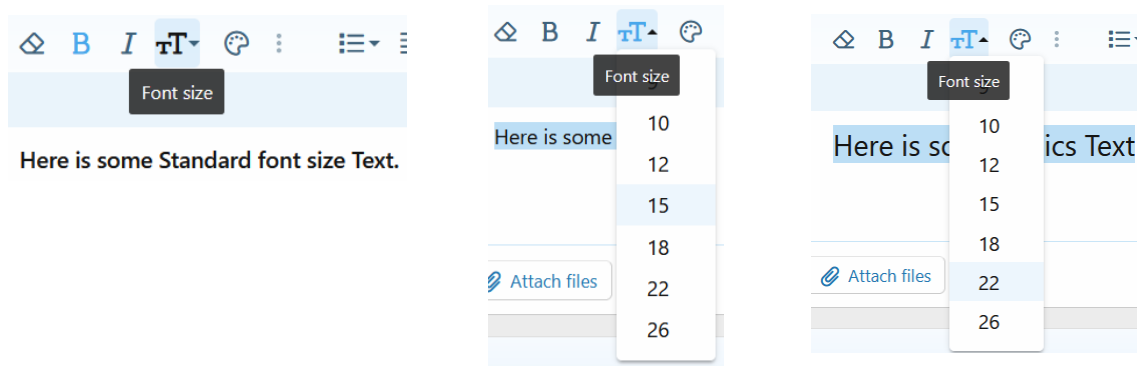
This is how you would change the font to **BOLD**.



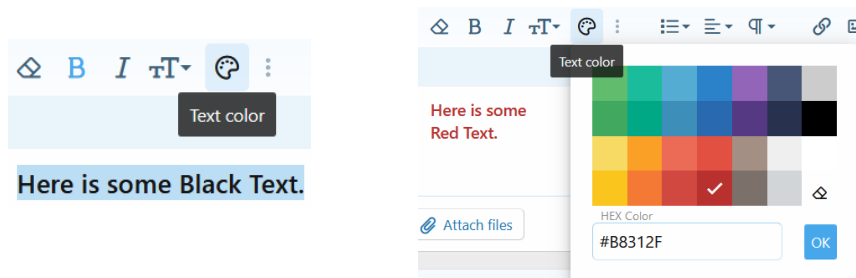
This is where you would change the font to **Italics**.



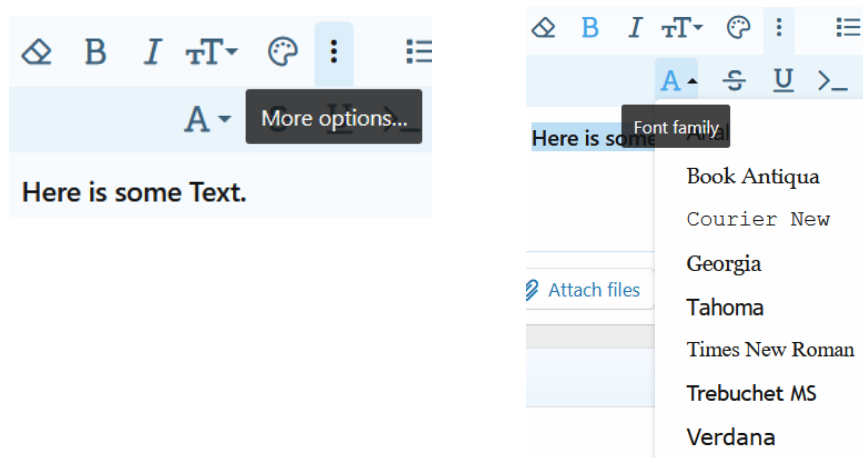
This is where you would change the **Font size**.



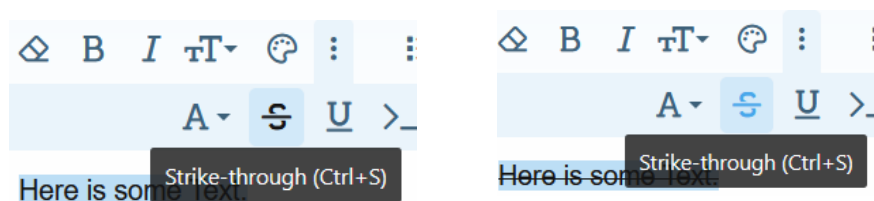
This is where you would change the **Font Color**.



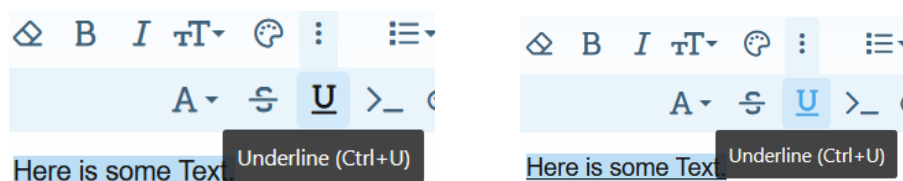
This is where you can change the **Font family**.



This is where you would do a **Strike-through** of your text.

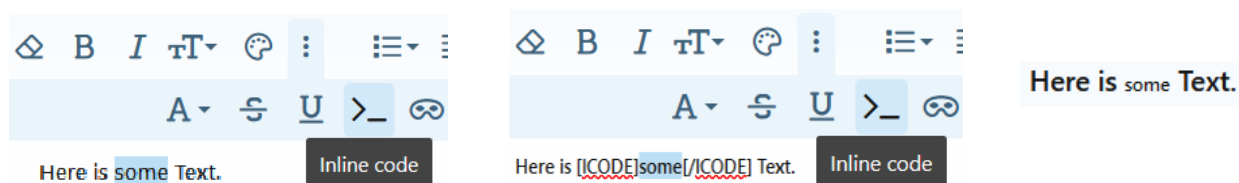


This is where you would do an **Underline** of your text.



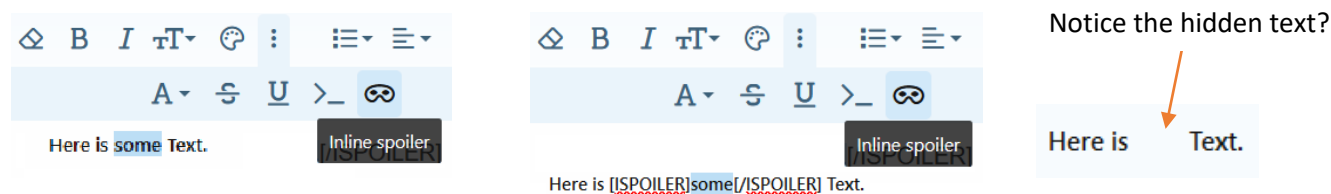
This is where you would do an **Inline code** of your text.

Allows you to display text inline code within normal text.

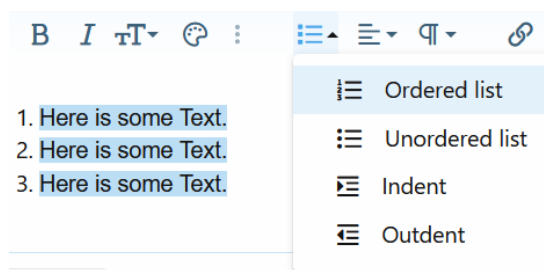


This is where you would do an **Inline spoiler** of your text

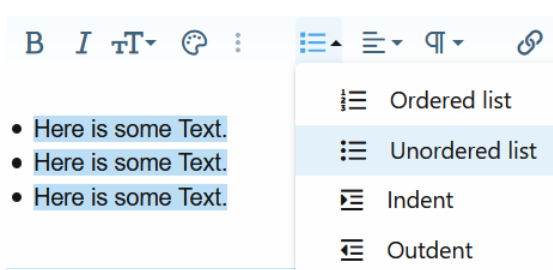
Allows you to display inline spoiler text within normal text which hides text that may contain spoilers and must be clicked by the viewer to be seen.



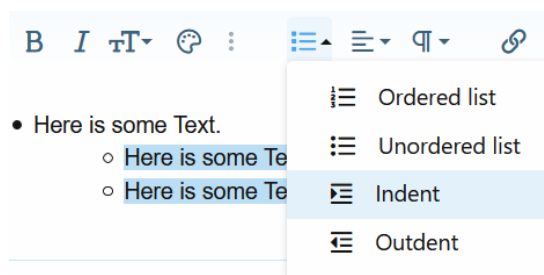
This is where you would create **Ordered Text**.



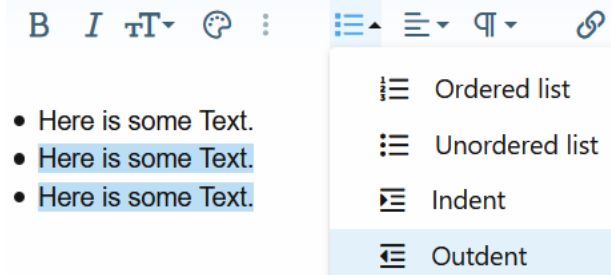
This is where you would create **Unordered Text**.



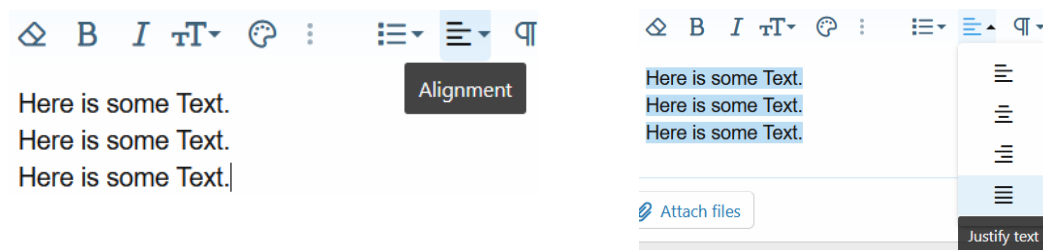
This is where you would **Indent** Text.



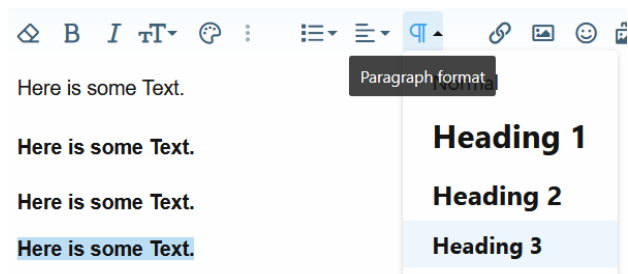
This is where you would **Outdent** Text.



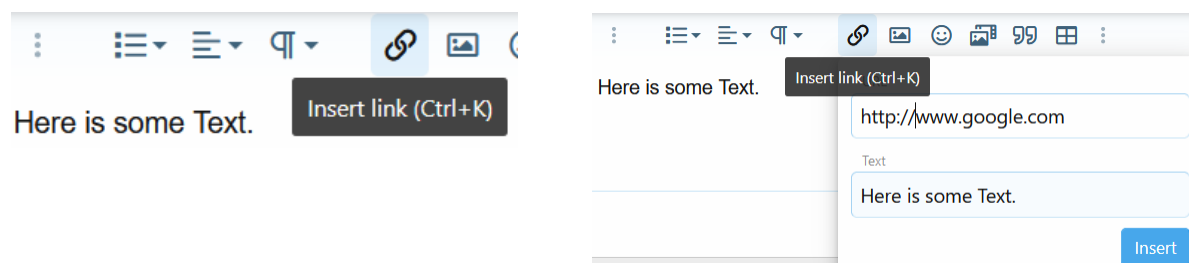
This is where you would set the **Alignment** of the Text.



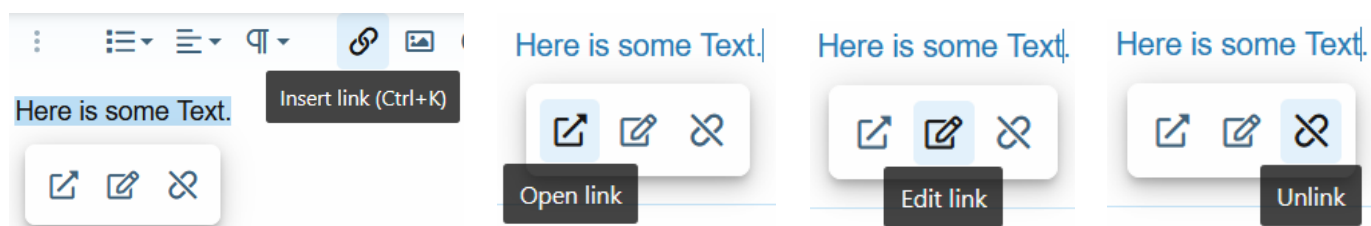
This is where you would set the **Headings** of the Text.



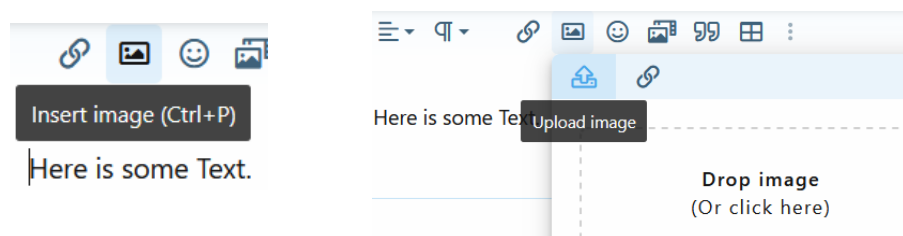
This is where you would **Insert a link** for the Text.



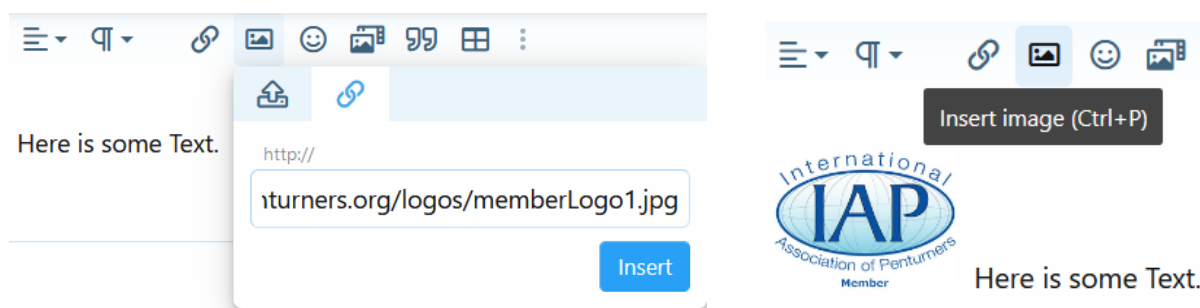
This is where you would **Open, Edit or Unlink** a link for the Text from above example.



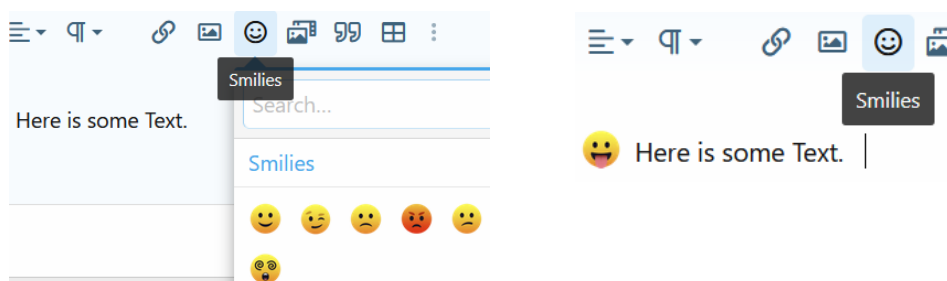
This is where you would **Insert a Local Drop Image**.



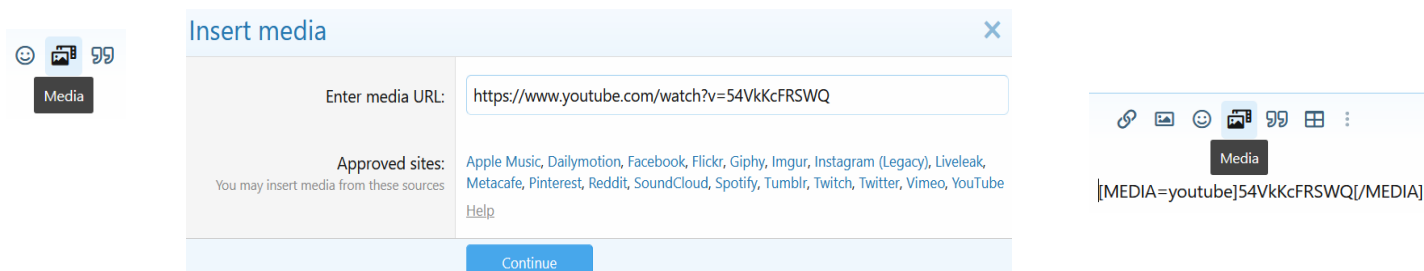
This is where you would **Insert a Web Link** instead of a local image.



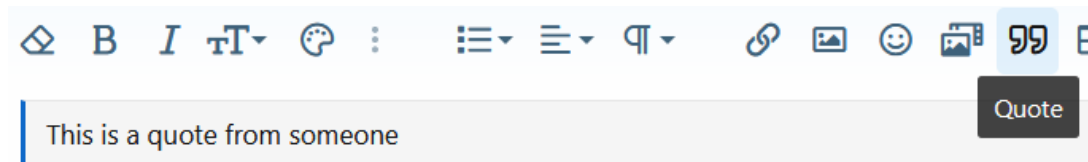
This is where the **Smilies** are inserted, click at the beginning of your text first.



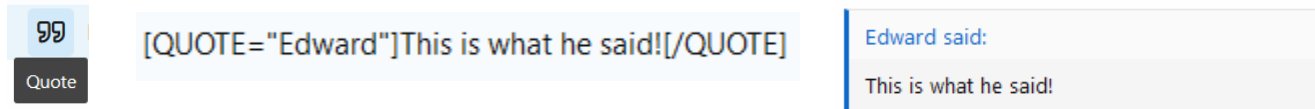
This is where you can **Insert media** from many offsite locations.



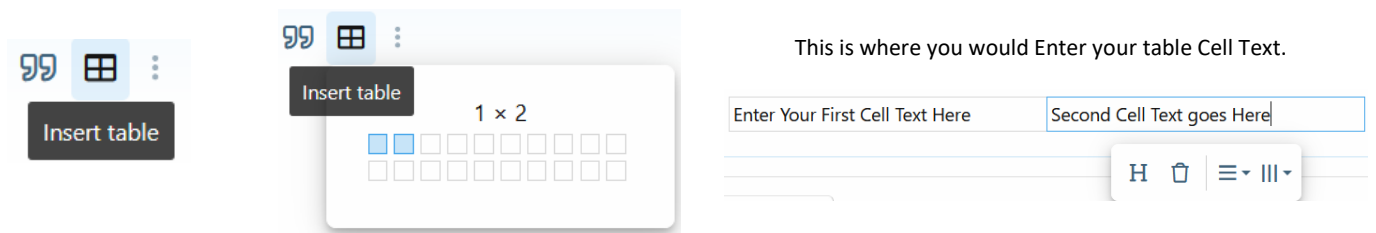
Using the Actual **Quote** icon does not allow the who said it.



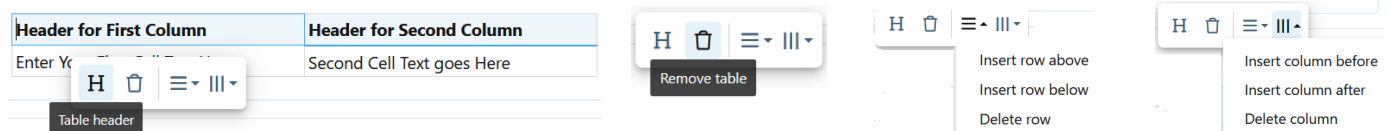
This is how you would Create a **Quote** with Edward said. Edit the bbcode:



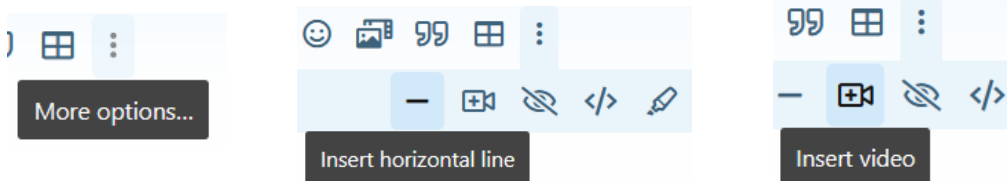
This is where you would create a **Table** and with the pop up select how many Rows and columns.



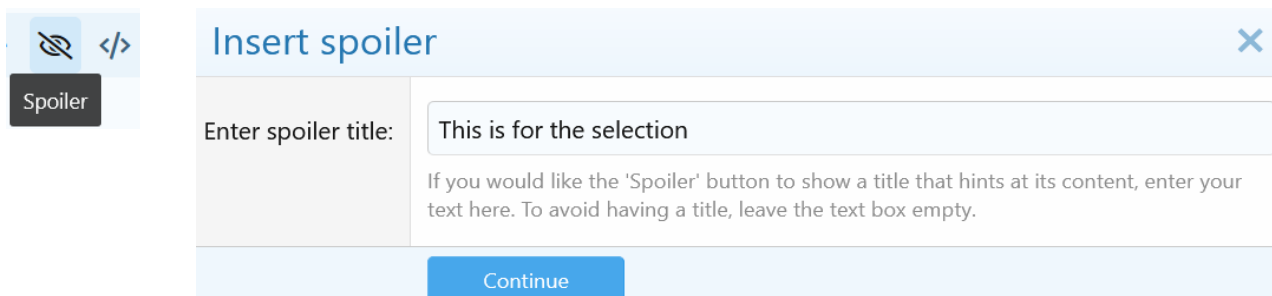
This are some Additional **Table Options**.



More **Options** are available under the vertical triple drop icon.



This is where you would add a **Spoiler**.

Enter the Text in the bbbcode as an Example saying, "What color is the tooltip".

[Spoiler="This a for the selection"]What color is tooltip?[/Spoiler]

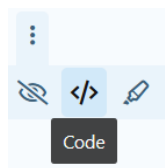
Click to reveal or hide

What color is tooltip?

"Click to reveal or hide" is the standard pop up.

Enter the Code that will not be interpreted, it will be displayed as **Code**. You can choose the actual language from the drop down.

Attach a file to Post. Make sure your cursor is in the correct location of your text. You can add many at the same time by holding down the <CTRL> key as you select more images. You can move them around later if you need to.

Select either Thumbnail or Full image to complete inserting image.



Last but not least!

Nobody is perfect and even professional editors and proofreaders miss typos occasionally. But do your best to polish everything you write before you share it with the world. After all, if you get dressed up in the morning, do your hair, and look great, but you forget to brush your teeth, what do you think people will notice first? The same is true of typos. Even the best content will be ignored if readers can't get past the glaring typos in your first sentence. Always take the time to edit and proofread. It's the final step before you present your work, and yourself, to the world.
